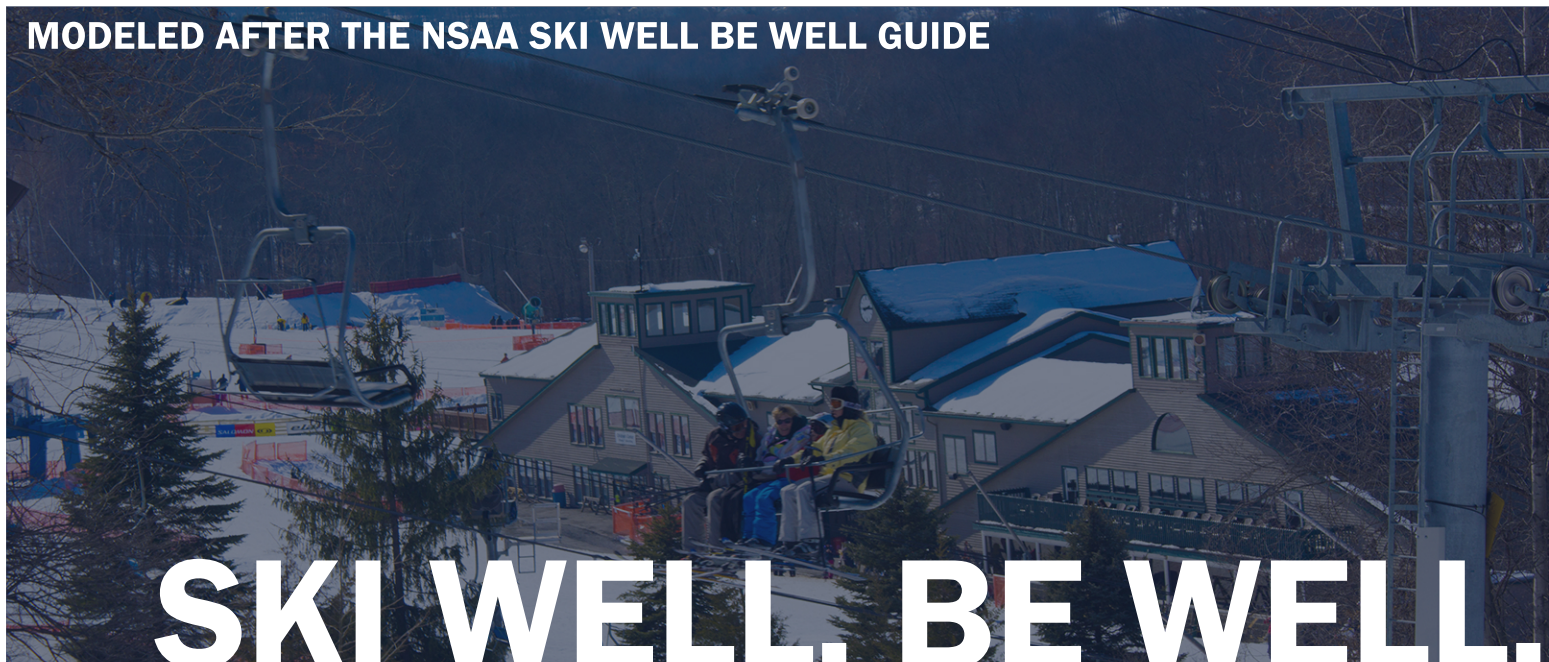


# WHAT TO EXPECT AT SHAWNEE MOUNTAIN THIS SEASON

## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!

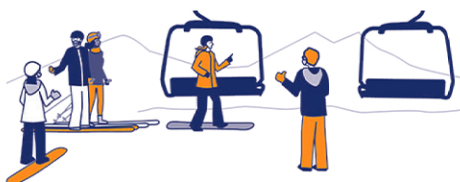

### OUTDOOR

This season, outdoor operations will look similar to how they did prior to the pandemic.

- Chairlifts will be loaded to capacity.
- Unrelated parties will be able to ride the lift together.
- Masks will be optional outside.
- You can expect standard organization of lift lines.
- Please wear a mask if you are high-risk or if you feel uncomfortable.



### INDOOR

This season, indoor operations will be a little different.

- Shawnee Mountain will be following all state and local health regulations.
- Protocols are subject to change throughout the season.
- Please follow all signage and requirements.

### PRO TIPS

- KNOW BEFORE YOU GO! Staying informed and being flexible are key this season!
- Keep a mask in your pocket – you'll always be prepared if you need one. Throw a mask in your kids pockets, too!

### VACCINATIONS

Shawnee Mountain will be following all state and federal guidelines for employee vaccinations and testing.

### MASKS

Our Shawnee Mountain employees are required to wear masks while indoors. Masks are not required for guests, but they are recommended for anyone coming inside.
